Impression Evidence Photography, Collection and Preservation
For Crime Scene Investigators

This course is designed to introduce crime scene investigators to techniques for locating, photographing and recovering three dimensional and two dimensional impression evidence during a systematic approach to a crime scene investigation. Students will be given hands-on exercises in photography, casting and lifting techniques.

The Department of Forensic Science will supply ALL necessary equipment to complete the course.

This course will be limited to 12 students and is restricted to personnel from Virginia law enforcement agencies.

The course will be taught by the Training Section at the Virginia Department of Forensic Science located at 737 N. 5th Street in Richmond, VA from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.
