Virginia Department of Forensic Science Basic Introduction to Bullet Trajectory Richmond, VA August 12, 2020

This one day workshop is designed to introduce personnel to the basics of bullet trajectory and the techniques associated with determining and photographing the prospective flight path of bullets. Students will also be taught how to assemble and utilize a kit used to chemically test potential bullet holes for the presence of lead.
